Assistant professorship (Tenure-track)

Candidates are expected to give courses in Japanese or English, and requested to give courses in Japanese after 3 years.

Research Area:

Mathematics and Mathematical Sciences

Qualification:

Doctoral degree (to be obtained before appointment)

Salary:

Based on the annual salary system as determined by the university.

As soon as possible after April 1, 2025.

Application Materials:

Consolidate the following information (1–7) into a single PDF file (up to 10MB).

1. Curriculum Vitae.
2. List of publications, selected talks, grants, etc.
3. Brief description of selected publications.
 - For co-authored publications, explain your contribution.
 - Do not attach papers to applications, but rather provide DOIs or URLs for download.
4. Research plan.
5. Teaching experience and the statement of the candidate's policy about teaching.
6. Names, affiliations, and e-mail addresses of three references who know your work.
7. Declaration of applicable specific categories (and evidences if necessary; see Notes below).

In case of leave associated to life events (such as child birth, etc.), the evaluation period may be extended. In case the evaluation does not result in a tenured position, a 1-year position as designated assistant professor will be granted when the term ends.

- This position is administered under the cooperations between Graduate School of Mathematics and Kobayashi–Maskawa Institute for the Origin and Particles and the Universe (KMI). The candidate would be affiliated with the Division of Theoretical Studies, String Theory and Mathematics Group, and he/she would be engaged in the graduate and undergraduate education at Graduate School of Mathematics.
- It is possible to apply for other announced positions in our department as well.
- The application materials will be disposed of appropriately as soon as the screening process is over.
- Please indicate in your CV if there are life events (such as childbirth, elderly care, etc.) that you wish to be considered by the search committee.
- In November 2021, in accordance with the clarification of the scope of control for “deemed exports” under the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act (“FEFTA”), some provision of sensitive technology to faculty members by universities and research institutions has become subject to control under the FEFTA. Consistently with this change, when applying for faculty positions, the applicant will be required to submit a “Declaration of applicable specific categories” based on the “Flowchart for determining applicable specific categories.” The successful applicant will also be required to submit a “Letter of confirmation” at the time of the recruitment.
